



BOX 13



Once a week at a regular time a public draw is made in which a number is drawn (1 – 100), and a winner is selected. The winner receives a prize of £50 plus the opportunity to select one of 13 keys which if correct will open a locked box containing a further bonus amount, which in the first week will be £100 and could rise up to £700. You do not have to be present in the Clubhouse to win. The draw is based upon 100 members who are entered into a draw at a cost of £2.50 per number, per week.

Should they not be present in the club at the time of the draw then a representative or other member will select the key.

In the event that the key does not open the box then that key is placed in the box (to prevent its re-use) and the draw moves on to the following week.



In week two the initial draw prize remains £50 but the bonus prize **is increased by a further £50** giving a total potential prize fund of **£200**. A winning number is drawn and one of the remaining keys is selected and the attempt to open Box 13. If successful the prize is awarded if not a further £50 is added to the bonus prize and so it goes on. The bonus prize will continue to be increased by £50 each week and the number of available keys will diminish until only one remains. **At that time the bonus prize will have accumulated to £700 plus the weekly prize of £50.**

When Box 13 is successfully opened a new draw will commence the following week and will be closed to new members after a second week so that you must be in it from then to win it and cannot sit and wait for the bonus prize fund to grow before entering.

Members can select the numbers that they wish to purchase for the draw on a first come first served basis and will retain such number(s) for as long as they wish.

Any “member” of the draw may at any time purchase additional numbers for any week and retains these additional numbers for that specific week only. Payment for additional numbers will be via the Clubs swipe card. Members will be asked to subscribe to Box 13 via Direct Debit, credit card, or cheque for 4 weeks at a time or longer as participants wish. Entry into the draw is restricted to Club members of all denominations **excluding** Juniors. All prize payments will be made via cheque.

Some will win large prizes which could be used to purchase a new trolley, a new set of clubs, or next years fees. Its good fun and statistically a better bet than the Lottery. As it's a restricted draw, someone you know will win.
