**Catering:**

**Dress:**

Society members are required to conform to the Stover Golf Club Dress Rules, which will be forwarded to event organisers. On the Course: No round or v-neck, rugby, football or tee shirts are permitted. Shirts must be kept tucked in within trousers or shorts. (Ladies only – Shirts below hip length must be tucked in). No blue denim, combat type trousers or tracksuits are permitted. Trousers must not be tucked into socks. Tailored shorts or golf skirts of a presentable length (not short and above the knee) may be worn with ankle to low cut predominately white sports socks. Knee length sock may also be worn. Golf Shoes must be worn. In the Lounge and Dining Room. A reasonable standard of dress and cleanliness is expected in the clubhouse at all times. Blue denim, combat type trousers, tracksuits, rugby, football or tee shirts, sports hats, sports shoes, trainers or golf shoes are not permitted. It is preferred that members and visitors change from clothes worn on the course before entering the Lounge and Dining room after finishing golf for the day, especially when play has taken place during inclement or oppressive weather conditions. If you are unable to abide by this Dress Code please use the Patio Bar.

**Mobile phones:**

Should not be switched on, on the course (except in an emergency) or in the Clubhouse.

**Nearest the Pin and Longest Drive:** Can be arranged for you, if you notify the Secretary in advance.

Society bookings are accepted on the understanding that the competitors are liable for any damage caused to property or third parties due to wayward golf shots. Any such damage must be reported to the Club Secretary or his representative immediately after completion of the round or sooner if convenient.
